

Advanced Costume Corrections "Tribe"

The following are corrections noted at the Dress Rehearsal on March 23. All corrections must be followed in order for your child to perform on stage.

CLOTHING

- All bras must be NUDE colored - no white or black.
- Underwear should be a NUDE colored thong. Make sure that the strap of the thong is thin - otherwise it will bunch up when their arms are raised.
- If you are using tights from last year, please check the tag and make sure they are Capezio and not Ovation.
- Zaria, Jennifer & Olivia: Please get new tights.
- Shoes must be clean and with no holes.
- Wear the shoe straps behind.
- Earrings are the only jewelry allowed. DO NOT wear any necklaces underneath.
- If you are wearing clip-on earrings, please use a piece of fashion tape to hold them in place. Put the tape on like a band-aid from front to back and put the earring on overtop.

HAIR

- Ponytails need to be up higher on top of the head. Ponytail should be aligned with the front of the ears.
- The ponytail on top of the head should be doubled or tripled up on hair bands to help it stand up higher.
- Hair should be more slicked in front and along the braid so there are no flyaways.
- "Pull" the braid so that it is not so tight.
- Hair ties should be the same color as your hair (ponytail) and same color or clear bands at the bottom of the braid.
- Haidyn: Please use brown hair ties.

MAKE-UP

- No nail polish. Clear polish or a French manicure are OK.
- Fake eyelashes.
- Emily, Marissa, Cailyn, Britteni & Kayla: More blush is needed.
- Jennifer: Darken creases with eyeshadow.

- White make-up must be applied darker so that it looks brighter on stage.
- White lines should be on the cheekbone, following the cheek-line to the temple, not straight across.
- Start the lines at the apple of the cheek and take them to the corner of the eye.
- Please make the lines thinner - not thick like a football player.
- Be sure to reapply the lipstick and the white lines before going on stage.
