“RAIN ON ME”

The following is required for **competition only**:

- *Freeform Jazz Shoe in Tan (ELITE JAZZ AND INTERMEDIATE 5 AND ADVANCED JAZZ)
- *Wonder Jazz Boot in Caramel (INTERMEDIATE 1-4 JAZZ)
- *Black Flexmaster Tap Shoes (TAP)
- *Black Pastry High Tops (HIP HOP)
- *Tan Transition Tights (JAZZ)
- *No-show Black socks (HIP HOP)
- *Hair in a high ponytail above the crown of the head. Wrap a piece of hair around the ponytail holder and secure with bobby pins. Please use gel or hairspray to slick back hair. No flyaways. Hair ties and bobby pins same as hair color.
- *A Nude bra must be worn under costume with straps straight back (DO NOT crisscross straps). Please no bodysuits or underwear.

Makeup:

Eyes:

- *White under eyebrow and in the inside and outside crease of the eye. Light grey on the eyelid and dark grey in the eyelid crease
- *Black Fake eyelashes (**for those in Intermediate 5 and above only**) then apply
 - ***Intermediate 5 and above only**: Black eyeliner top and bottom lid and Black mascara top and bottom lashes
 - ***Intermediate 1-4**: Black eyeliner on top lid only and Black mascara top and bottom
- *Any rose-colored blush from the apple of the cheek to the temples

Lipstick:

- *L'oreal Colour Riche **317 Ruby Flame** (Lipstick available for purchase at the LP front desk. We will let you know when it is available. Makeup sales are cash only)
- **Makeup must be applied to stand out on stage****

- *Make sure all costume pieces, including shoes and props, are labeled with students name or initials
- *Earrings available for purchase at the LP front desk
- *No other jewelry or nail polish
- ***MOLLY KLOSE, SHANNON ZEHNER AND MEGAN GARDNER** Please come in full costume (hair and make-up) on **TUESDAY, February 23 to your regularly scheduled Production Class**. Your picture will be taken at this time. Due to the current circumstances, there will be no hair and makeup tutorial in class.
